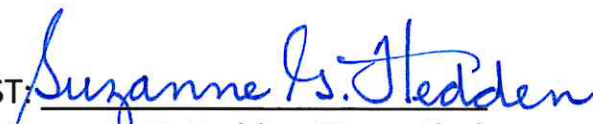
Public Hearing for Alcohol Sales before noon on Sunday in the Town of Hayesville

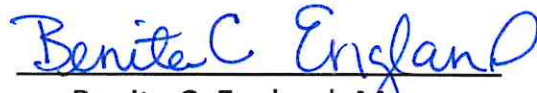

Mayor England opened the Public Hearing at 6:30 pm. She then read the Alcohol Sales before noon on Sunday ordinance identifying the purpose of the meeting for all in attendance. Anthony McDonald spoke first stressing that his purpose for pursuing the Brunch Bill is trying to bring tax revenue/tourists into town.
